



## Integrated Quality and Safety Policy

Eurodocks believes it is of fundamental importance to have an internal organization that allows to harmonize and control their processes and the collection of information deriving from them through the application of the integrated Quality and Safety Management system, compliant with UNI EN ISO 9001: 2015 and UNI ISO 45001: 2018 standards; through continuous updating and improvement of its HACCP Self-Control Plan and through the application of the voluntary GMP + scheme and the EC 834/07 and EC 889/08 Regulations regarding products from organic farming.

For this purpose Eurodocks undertakes to:

- consolidate the market position achieved in its business sector, effectively managing changes that may affect the organization, solving customer and / or structural problems as quickly as possible;
- ensure compliance with the needs of customers, shareholders, interested parties, employees, collaborators and suppliers, in a professional and serious way, monitoring the objectives assigned and shared at all stages of the process to provide a quality service;
- make adequate technical-economic resources available;
- prevent accidents, occupational diseases and in any case accidents that could cause damage to people and things;
- comply with current and future legislation on health and safety in the workplace;
- identify and evaluate in advance the health and safety risks deriving from the activities, also in relation to the goods handled, the materials and equipment used;
- ensure the safety and integrity of products for food and livestock use stored in their warehouses through continuous monitoring;
- adopt all the consequent and necessary measures and provisions to prevent or eliminate causes of risk to human health and safety in general;
- promote professionalism, a sense of responsibility and awareness of the impact that their activity has on the health and safety of everyone among employees, through the implementation of training courses, information and training, involvement and consultation of workers, including through their safety representative;
- adhere to programs to improve the safety of activities, in particular port activities, promoted by interested parties, such as the Port Authority of Ravenna, the Port Authority of Ravenna and the workers' unions;
- the continuous improvement of the integrated management system, establishing objectives annually supported by suitable implementation programs, providing tools to achieve them, assigning implementation responsibilities at the appropriate levels;
- verify annually and whenever necessary, the results achieved by evaluating the effectiveness of the integrated management system and compliance with this policy.
